License Your Pet Online: Go to www.petdata.com/broward. Under License Now, click "Online." The rabies certificate may be uploaded or submitted later by email, mail or fax. Pay with a major credit card. A convenience fee will apply per transaction.

License Your Pet by Mail: Complete this application, **Enclose a copy of your pet's current rabies vaccination certificate**, Enclose the microchip number if not on file, Make your check or money order payable to Board of County Commissioners - Animal Care Division *(please do not send cash)* **Mail to:** Broward County Animal Licensing, c/o PetData, PO Box 141929, Irving TX 75014-1929. Paperwork will not be returned.

License Your Pet in Person: Go to Broward County Animal Care at 2400 SW 42nd St in Fort Lauderdale or participating veterinary clinics. Bring a copy of your pet's current rabies vaccination certificate. Tags purchased at a veterinary office are subject to a service fee not to exceed \$5.00 per tag.
